RE: CONSISTENT CAMPAIGN BY A PRETENDER AND
IMPOSTOR TO THE OFFICE OF PRESIDENT OF THE
ASSOCIATION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENTS OF NIGERIA
(ALGON), MR MAIFATA AMINU MUAZU TO
UNDERMINE THE JUDGMENT OF THE SUPREME
COURT OF NIGERIA ON FINANCIAL AUTONOMY FOR
LOCAL GOVERNMENTS IN NIGERIA

1. We are Solicitors to the Board of Trustees of the Association of Local Governments of Nigeria (ALGON), hereinafter called "our client". It is on its instructions that we write this letter.
2. Please recall the recent epochal judgment of the Supreme Court of Nigeria which granted financial autonomy for local governments of Nigeria. Kindly accept our sincere congratulations for this great achievement that brought about the observance of the three (3) tiers of government as recognized by

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the Constitution of the Federal Republic of Nigeria, 1999 (as amended).

3. The government has now gone ahead to inaugurate a 10-man inter-ministerial committee (of which your goodself is the Chairman) to implement the said judgement. This is as it should be and it is obviously a step in the right direction, as orders of court are not made in vain.
4. It has however come to our notice that certain unpatriotic elements are bent on throwing spanners in the works of your laudable initiative and attempting to scuttle the enforcement of the said judgment of the apex court. Sir, one of the arrow-heads of that ignoble enterprise is the above named Mr Maitama Aminu Muazu who has been falsely parading himself as the purported president of the Association of Local Governments of Nigeria (ALGON), unlawfully and illegitimately.
5. This is because, the said Mr. Muazu was never elected nor did he emerge as the president of ALGON in accordance with extant provisions of the constitution of ALGON. We here refer in this regard to **Articles 14.1.1, 14.2(a) & (b), 5.5.1 (b), (c) and 8** thereof. A copy of the said constitution is herewith attached and marked "**ANNEXURE A**" for ease of reference.
6. It is important to state that no competent court in Nigeria has conferred that status of president on him, or pronounced him as such in any proceedings howsoever and whatsoever. For the foregoing reasons, we reasonably believe that the said conduct of Mr Muazu is inimical to public good and the due administration of justice, for if unchecked, it has the potential to provoke a breakdown of law and order within the ALGON group and


expose the hallowed institution of the judiciary to public opprobrium and ridicule.

This must never be allowed, for by virtue of the provisions of **Section 287** of the constitution, the judgments of every court must be obeyed by all persons, institutions and governments without question.

7. We, therefore, urge you to use your good offices and all legitimate instruments of state at your disposal to call the said Mr. Muazu to order. We urge your respected inter-ministerial not to deal with the said Mr Muazu as a member of your committee. He has been at the vanguard of serial campaigns against the full implementation and enforcement of the said judgment of the Supreme Court. Our client shall promptly send you the name of its accredited representative at your committee to protect the interest of the entirety of ALGOM as an incorporated group with full powers to sue and be sued.

8. While looking forward to your prompt response, kindly accept the assurances of our highest professional regards and esteem.

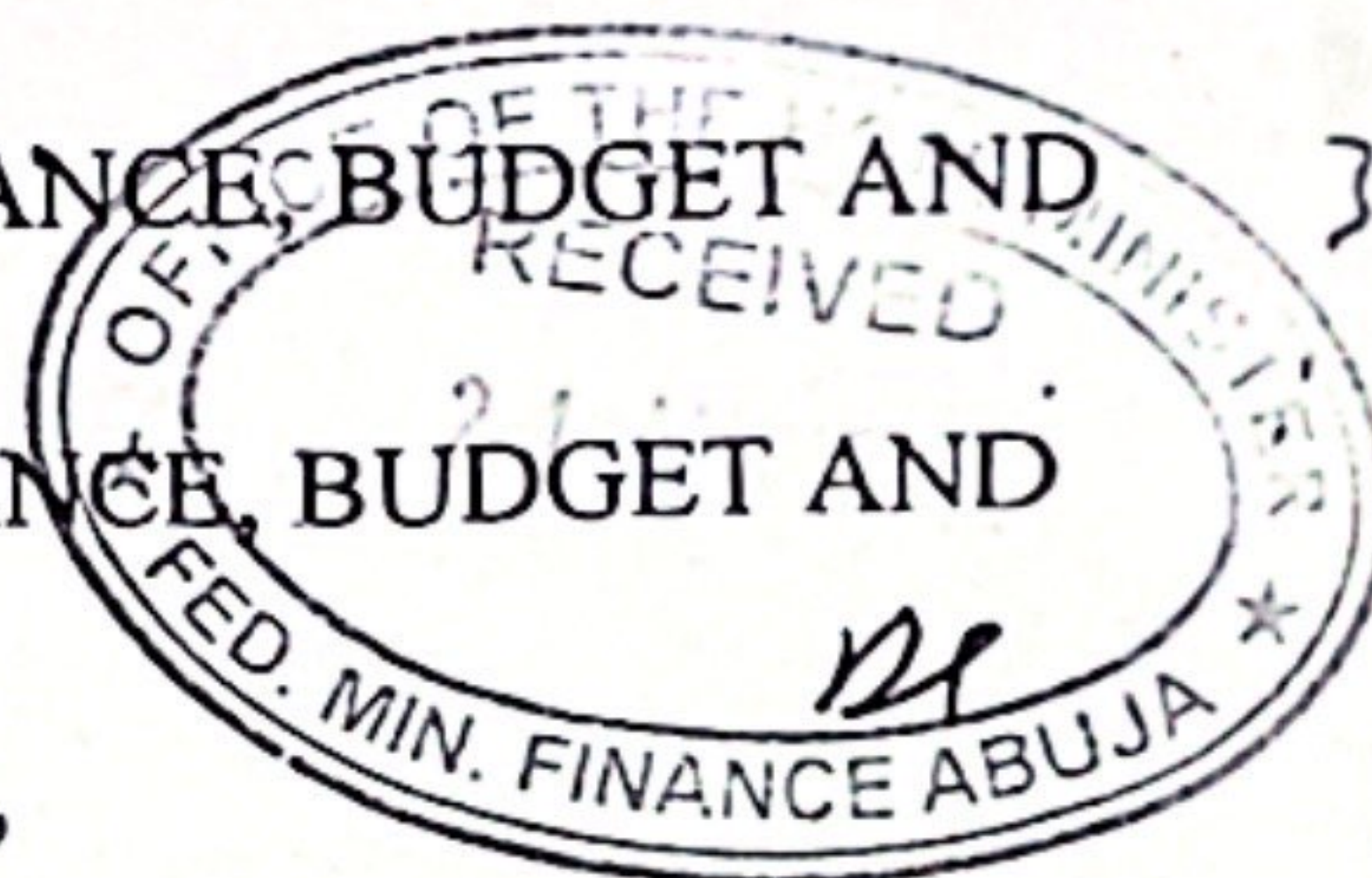

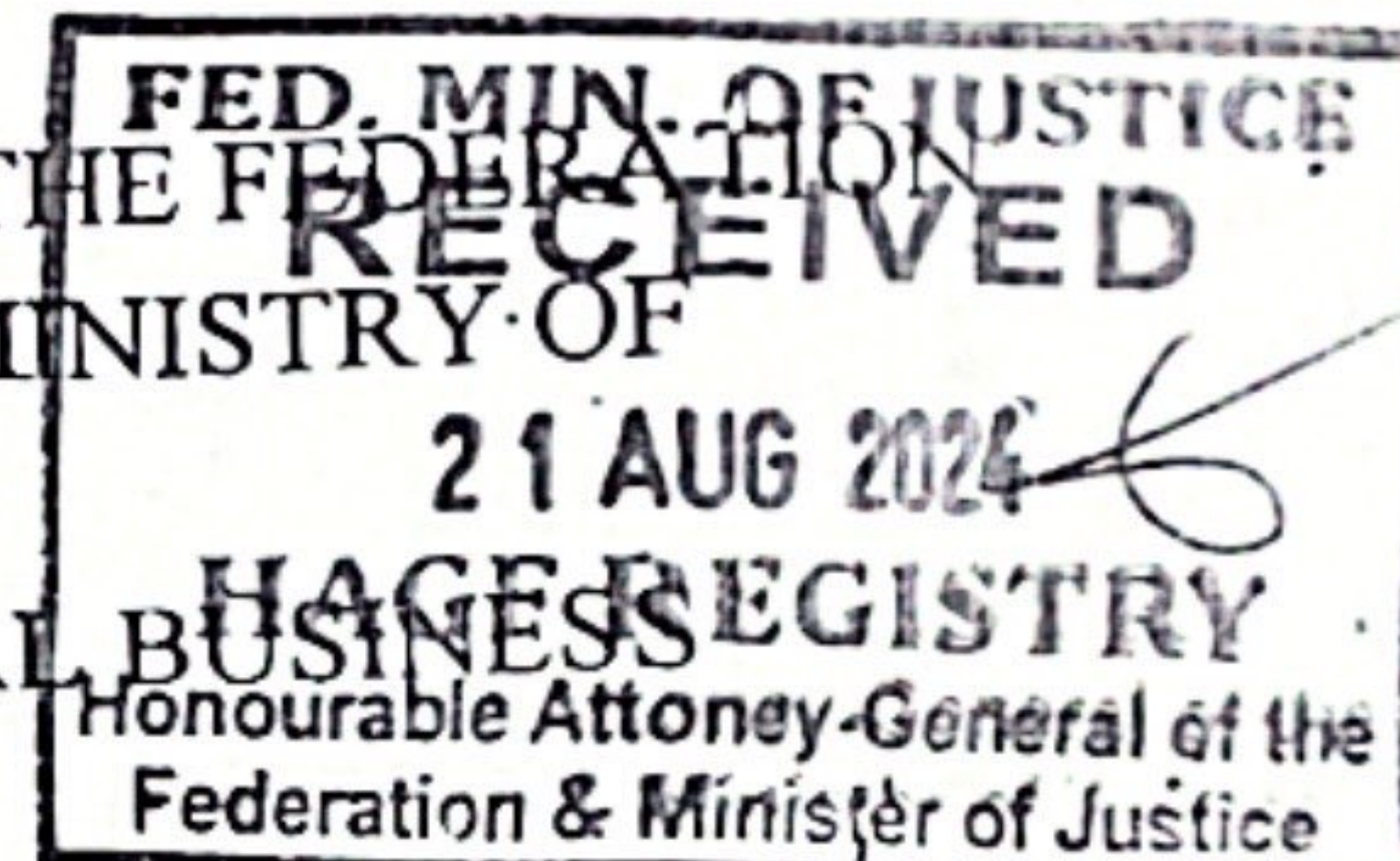



THE CONSTITUTION OF THE "ASSOCIATION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENTS OF NIGERIA" (ALGON)

1. NAME AND SEAT

1.1 **NAME:** There is hereby established an Association to be known and called the "Association of Local Governments of Nigeria (ALGON)" hereinafter called The Association", which shall have a common seal and perpetual succession and can sue and be sued in its own name.

1.2 **SEAT:** The headquarters of the Association shall be at Abuja; the Federal Capital Territory of Nigeria.

2. OBJECTIVES ✓

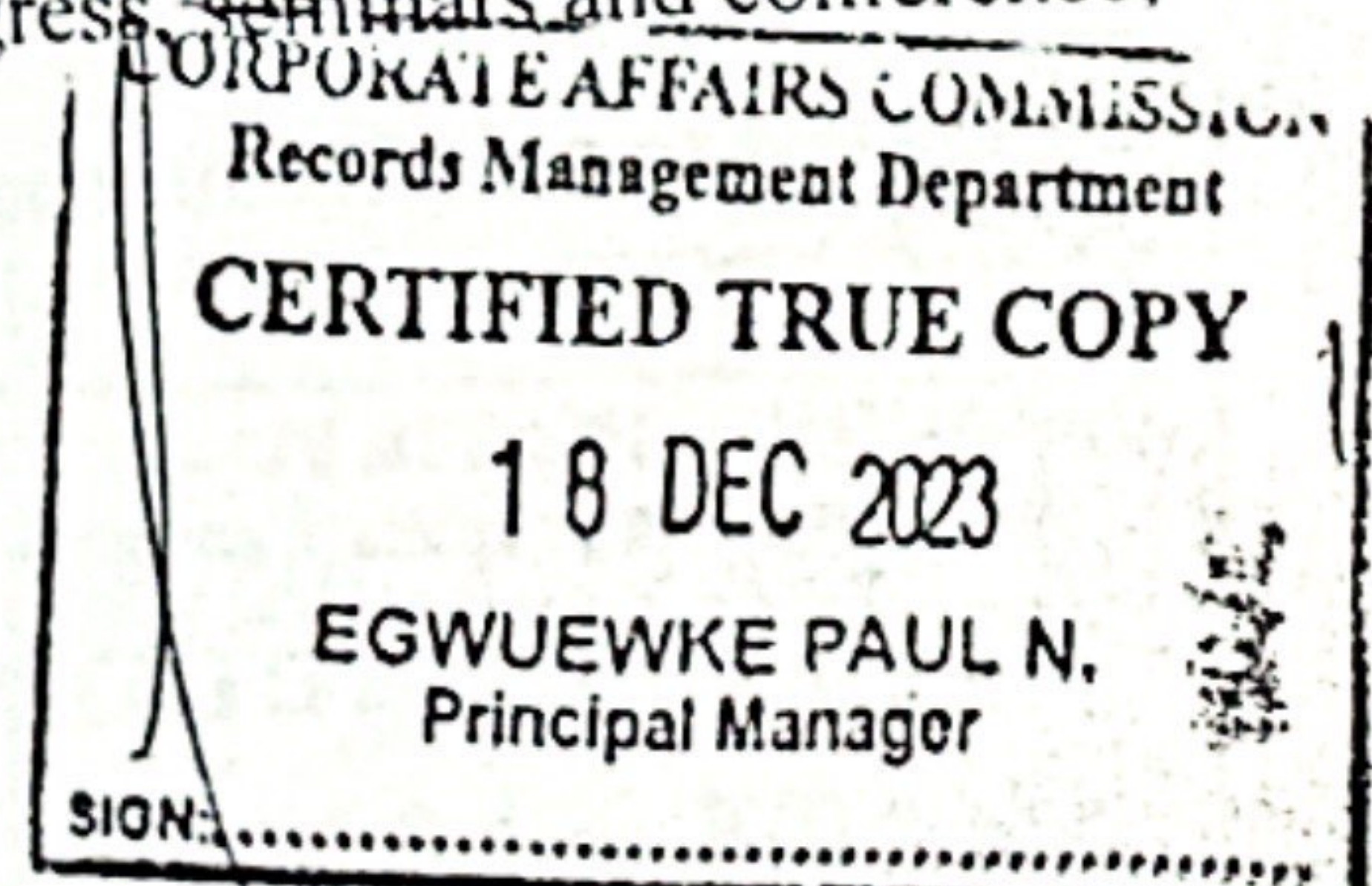
The objectives of the Association shall be to:

- i. promote and protect the interests, rights privileges and autonomy of Local Government at all times;
- ii. encourage Local Governments execute the functions constitutionally assigned to them efficiently and effectively;
- iii. promote and encourage professionalism in Local Government Services and contribute towards the improvement of Local Government Administration and services;
- iv. provide a forum for discussion among members and with other relevant bodies on matters of interest to Local Government;
- v. express the views/opinions of Local Government on Federal/State Government policies/legislation affecting them as well as on other Local Government issues of national and global concerns;
- vi. offer advisory services to members and disseminate information on matters of importance to Local Government;
- vii. encourage investigation and research into matters relating to Local Government;
- viii. promote Inter-Local government co-operation/networking and joint ventures;
- ix. initiate such actions, as may be desirable and necessary to advance the interest of Local Government as a third tier of Government.

3. FUNCTIONS

The functions of the Association shall include:

- (1) The periodical organization of Local, State, National and International Training Programmes, courses, congress, seminars and conference;



- (ii) Collection, collation, study and distribution of information in the field of Local Government;
- (iii) The provision of facilities, and services, including provision of journals, magazines and other documentaries to improve Local Government administration in Nigeria;
- (iv) Rendering expert advice and services on Local Government matters;
- (v) Providing consultancy services intended to enhance the availability of high-level manpower for the Local Governments;
- (vi) Providing support services to Local Governments;
- (vii) Advising the State and Federal Governments on Local Government policies and other related matters;
- (viii) Co-operation with other national and international bodies on matters of common interest to Local Governments;
- (ix) Organizing exchange programmes for Local Governments within and outside the country;
- (x) All other lawful functions which may further the objectives of the Association.

4. MEMBERSHIP:

4.1 The Association shall consist of:

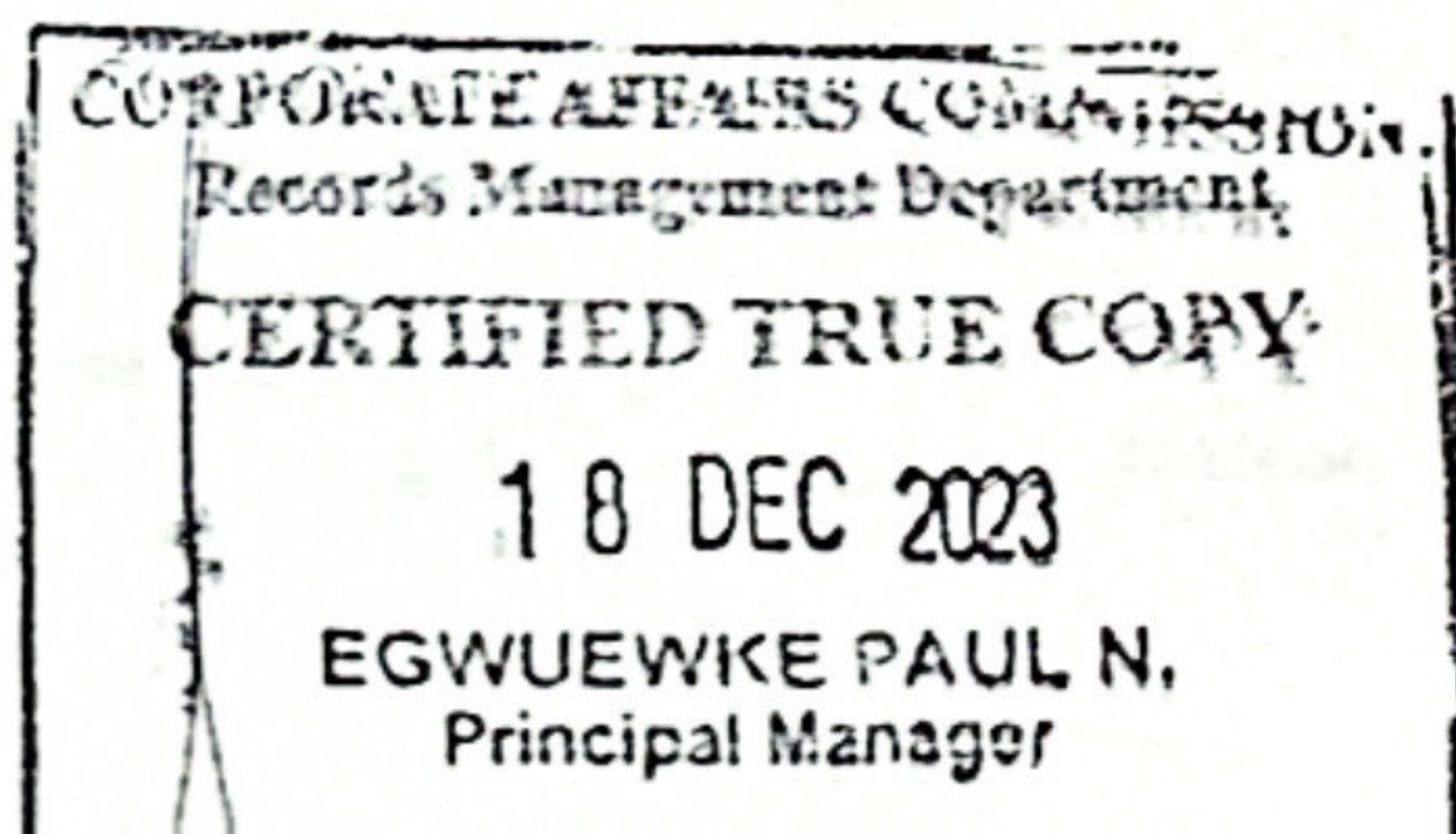
- (i) Permanent members
- (ii) Special members
- (iii) Honorary members

4.2 Permanent Members

All Local Governments in the Federation shall be permanent members of the Association.

4.3 Special Members

Person(s) appointed by the Association on the recommendation of National and or State Chapters for their interest and contribution in Local Government Affairs.



4.4 Honorary Members

Reputable person(s) appointed by the Association at the General Assembly.

5. **ORGANS OF THE ASSOCIATION**

The organs of the Association shall comprise:

(i) The General assembly

(a) All Chairmen of 774 Local Government Councils

(b) All Vice Chairmen of the 774 Local Government Councils and

(c) All elected Councillors in the 774 Local Government Councils

(ii) The National Executive Council;

President, Deputy President, Vice-Presidents, Auditor, Financial Secretary,

Treasurer, Publicity Secretary, Legal Adviser, Secretary General shall be an Ex-

officio, Assistant Auditor, Assistant Financial Secretary, Assistant Treasurer, Assistant Publicity Secretary, Assistant Legal Adviser and six Ex-officio Members elected from the Six political zones.

(iii) State Executive Council

(iv) Standing Committee/Establishment/Management, Finance and Planning, Joint Consultative, Education, Research and Training and Membership Service/Publicity.

(v) State Chapters:

All Chairmen of Local Government Councils in a State.

5.1.1 **THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY:**

The General Assembly shall consist of all members and officers of the Association.

5.1.2 **THE NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL:**

The National Executive Council shall comprise of all Principal officers and state Chairman of ALGON

5.1.3 **STANDING COMMITTEE:**

There shall be the following standing committees:

(i) Finance and Planning

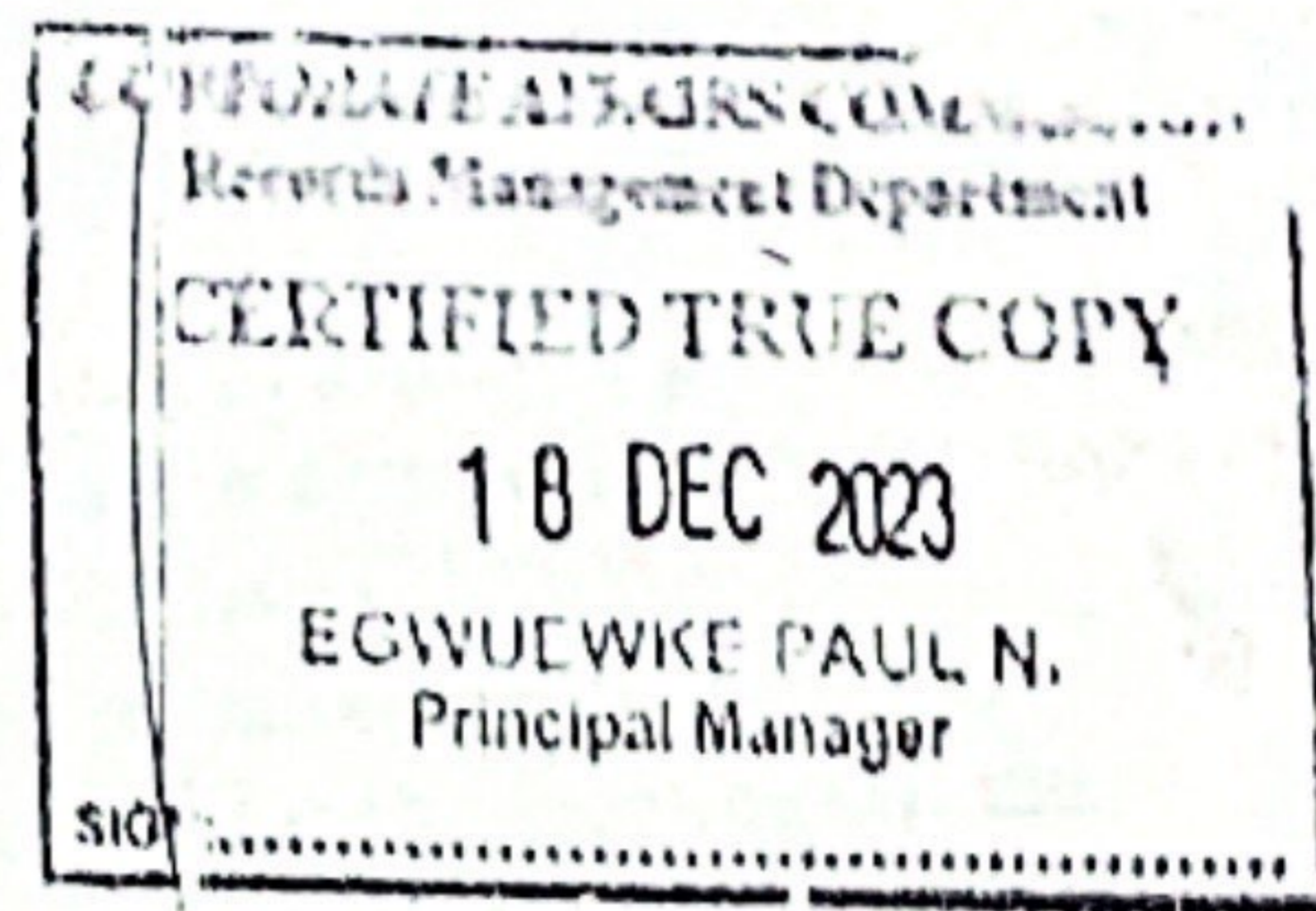
(ii) Joint Consultative

(iii) Education, Research and Training

(iv) Health and Environment

(v) Agriculture and Natural Resources

(vi) Inter-governmental Relations.



5.2 AD-HOC COMMITTEES

The Executive Council and/or the principal officers may also establish an Ad-Hoc Committee on any matter of interest to the Association.

5.2.1 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY:

There shall be a General Assembly of the Association, which shall;

- (a) Be the highest of the Association;
- (b) Meet at least once in a year on a day and at a place to be fixed by the National Executive Council;
- (c) Elect all principal officers of the Association every 2 [Two] years

5.3 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL:

- (a) Consider and prove Annual Budgets of the Association before implementation;
- (b) Adopt reports of the Principal Officers of the Association
- (c) Consider any other matters of interest to the Association.

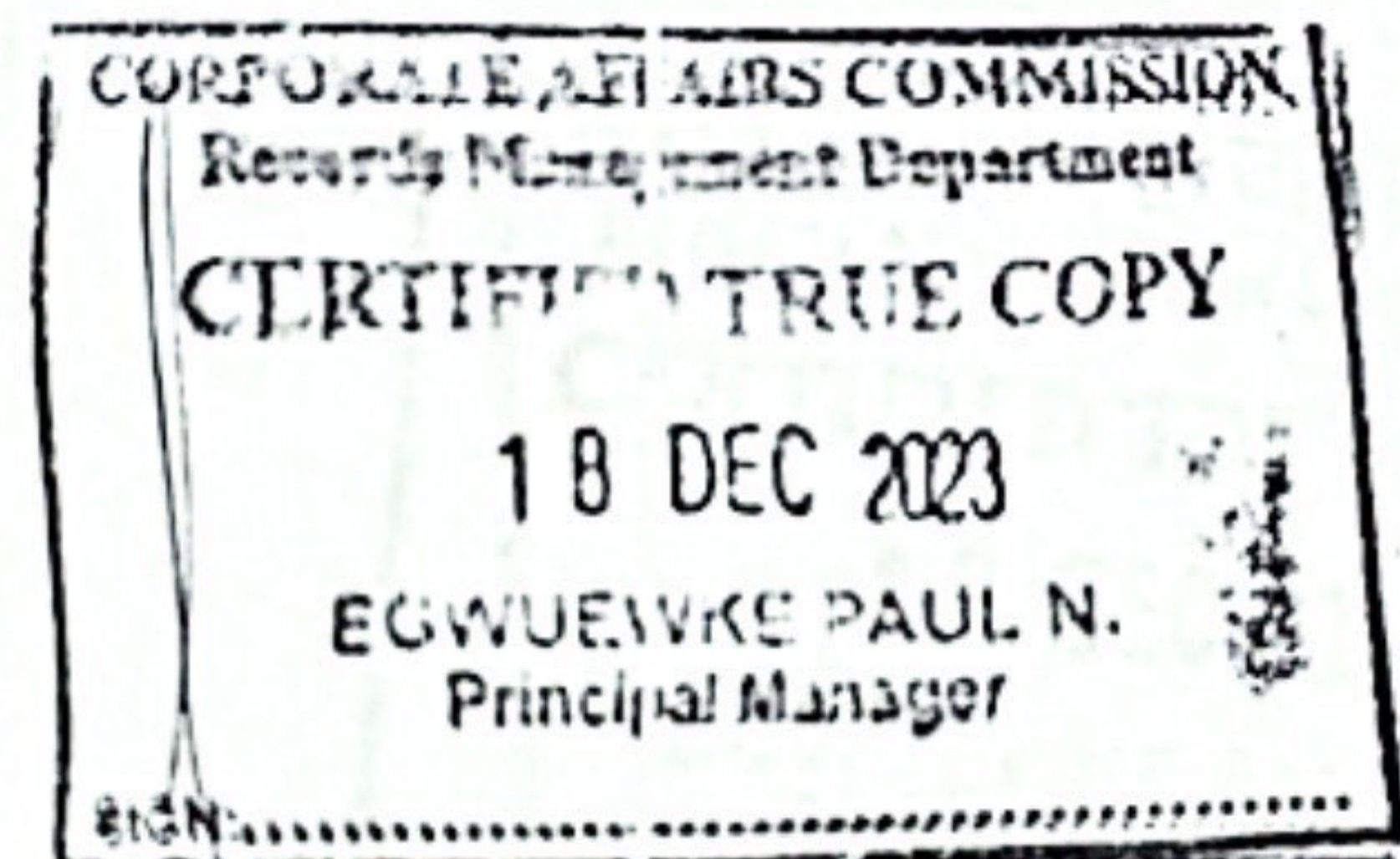
6. THE NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL:

6.1 The Association shall be under the Management of the National Executive Council whose functions may include:

- (a) Conducting the business of the Association in accordance with this constitution and subject to the decisions and directions of the General Assembly;
- (b) Preparing the annual financial statements and the budget for the consideration of the General Assembly;
- (c) Making recommendations to the General Assembly on annual subscriptions payable by members;
- (d) Making recommendations to the General Assembly on defaulting members;
- (e) Handling the appointment and discipline of the staff of the Association;
- (f) Making recommendations to the General Assembly on the conditions of service of the staff of the Association;
- (g) Convening the annual and extra-ordinary meetings of the General Assembly.
- (h) Elect the Trustees of the Association from its members.

6.2 The National Executive Council shall meet at least once in a quarter provided that the President on a written request may summon emergency or extra-ordinary meetings by at least one third of the members of the National Executive Council.

6.3 The National Executive Council shall make recommendations to the General Assembly on the standing orders and rules of procedure for the meetings of the Association.



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7 QUORUM:

The Quorum at all meetings of the Association and its organs shall be one third of the total membership in each case.

8 NOTICE OF MEETING OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY:

Not less than three months notice shall be given of the meeting and the Agenda for the meeting shall be sent to the members of the Association not less than one month before the meeting.

9 EMERGENCY MEETINGS:

Emergency or extra-ordinary meetings of the Association of which one month's notice shall be given, stating the purpose of such a meeting, can be called at any time by the Council or by the President, or by resolutions from at least eighteen chapters of the Association.

10 VOTING:

At all the meetings of the Association, and its committees, Honorary and Special Members shall have no voting rights. The members at the meeting shall decide the mode of voting.

11 DUTIES OF OFFICERS:

11.1 PRESIDENT

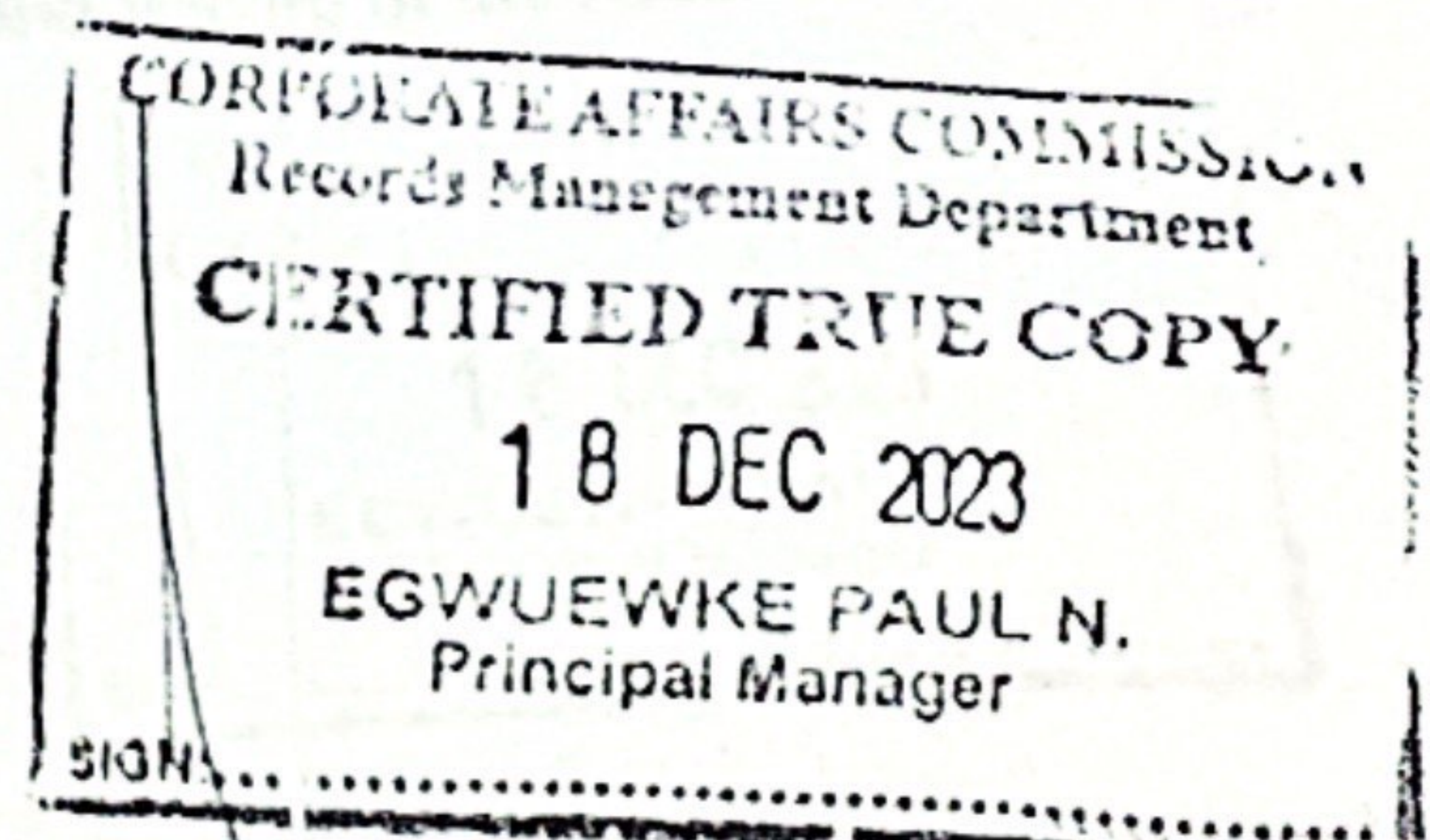
The President shall:

- (a) Provide leadership for the Association and be its spokesman on all matters;
- (b) Preside over meeting of
 - (i) The General Assembly
 - (ii) The National Executive Council
 - (iii) The finance and Planning Committee, and
 - (iv) The joint Consultative Committee
- (c) present an annual report to the General Assembly.
- (d) The President shall be the Chief Executive and the Accounting Officer of the Association.

11.2 DEPUTY PRESIDENT:

The Deputy President shall:

- (i) Exercise the powers and functions of the President in his absence;
- (ii) Perform all other duties as may be assigned to him by the President and the National Executive Council



11.2.1 The Deputy President shall in the event of the death, incapacitation, removal or resignation of the President, be deemed to have been elected to complete the remaining period of the President's term of office.

11.3 VICE PRESIDENT

(a) There shall be 37 Vice Presidents to represent each chapter in the Federation and must have been elected as the State Chapter Chairman or State Representative of the National Council. In the absence of the President and the Deputy President, one of the Vice Presidents selected from amongst themselves, shall preside over the National Executive Council and the General Assembly.

(b) In the event of electing a Chapter Chairman into any office of the National Executive Council, the Deputy Chairman in the State Chapter shall act as the Chairman of such State Chapter and also where the State Chairman voluntarily elects to resign his/her State Chapter Chairmanship.

11.4 THE TREASURER

- (i) The Treasurer shall be the custodian of the funds of the Association and also take overall responsibility for its finances.
- (ii) He shall be a co-signatory of the accounts of the Association.
- (iii) He shall present annual financial statement of the Association to the National Executive Council.

11.5 THE LEGAL ADVISER

- (i) He shall advise the Association on all legal matters.
- (ii) He shall be a member at all Committee General Meetings of the Association.

11.6 AUDITORS ✓

There shall be Internal Auditors appointed by the General Assembly to audit the accounts of the Association at such times as may be required, such audit report shall be presented to the General Assembly.

11.7 EXTERNAL AUDITORS

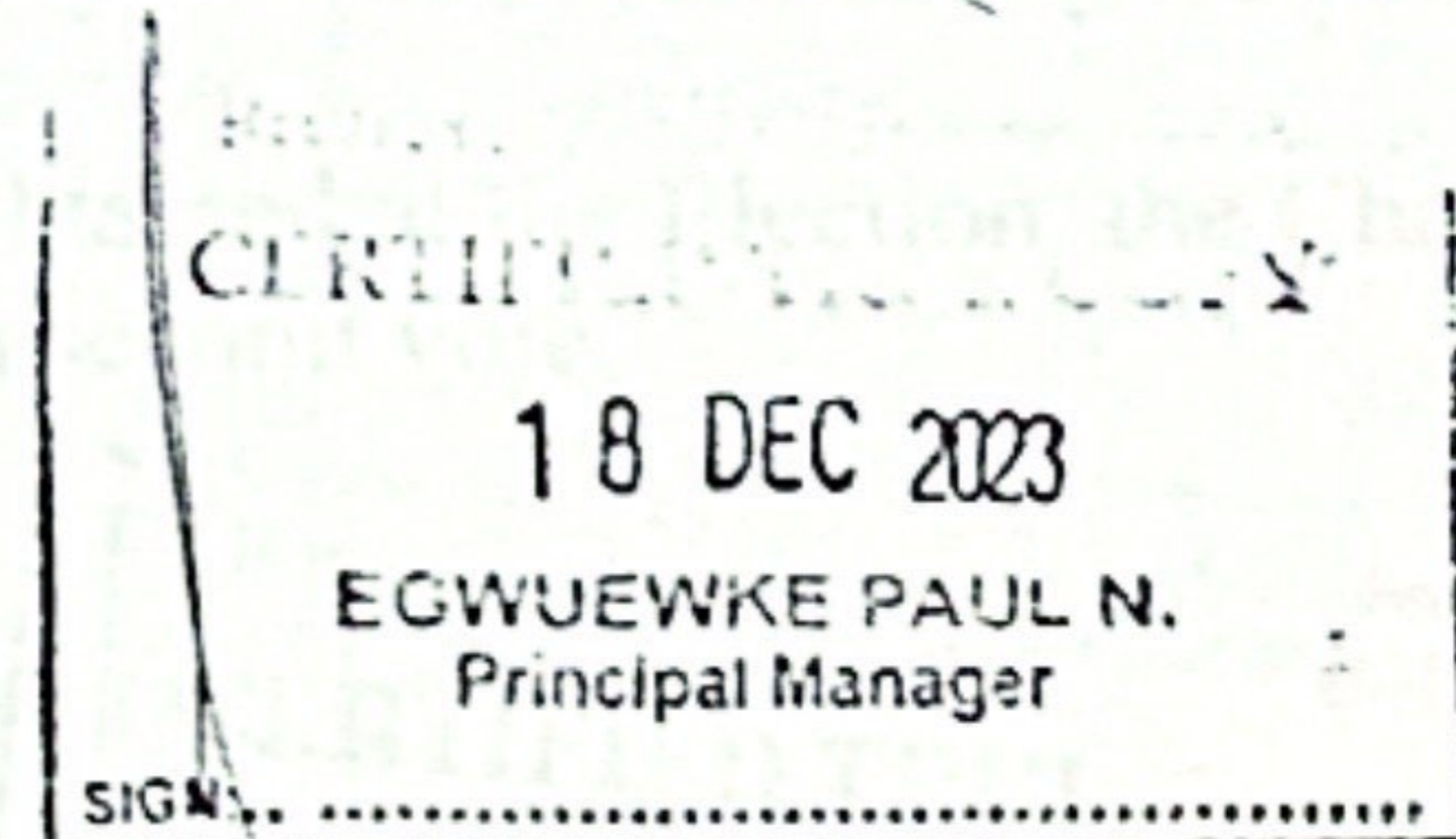
The National Executive Council shall when deemed necessary and ratified by the General Assembly, appoint a firm of External Auditors who shall conduct an annual audit of the Association's finances.

11.8 THE PUBLICITY SECRETARY

He shall oversee the publicity of the Association.

11.9 THE FINANCIAL SECRETARY

There shall be for the Association a Financial Secretary who will be responsible for keeping an Accounts and Record of the Association.



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12. TENURE

All officers of the Association shall be in office for 2[two] years and shall be eligible for re-election for another 2[Two] years-term.

12.1 PRIVILEGES:

- 12.1.1 The President, the Deputy President, the Secretary and the Treasurer shall be entitled to allowances as may be determined by the National Executive Committee
- 12.1.2 A retiring President shall retain his membership of the Association for a period of twelve months from the date of his retirement.

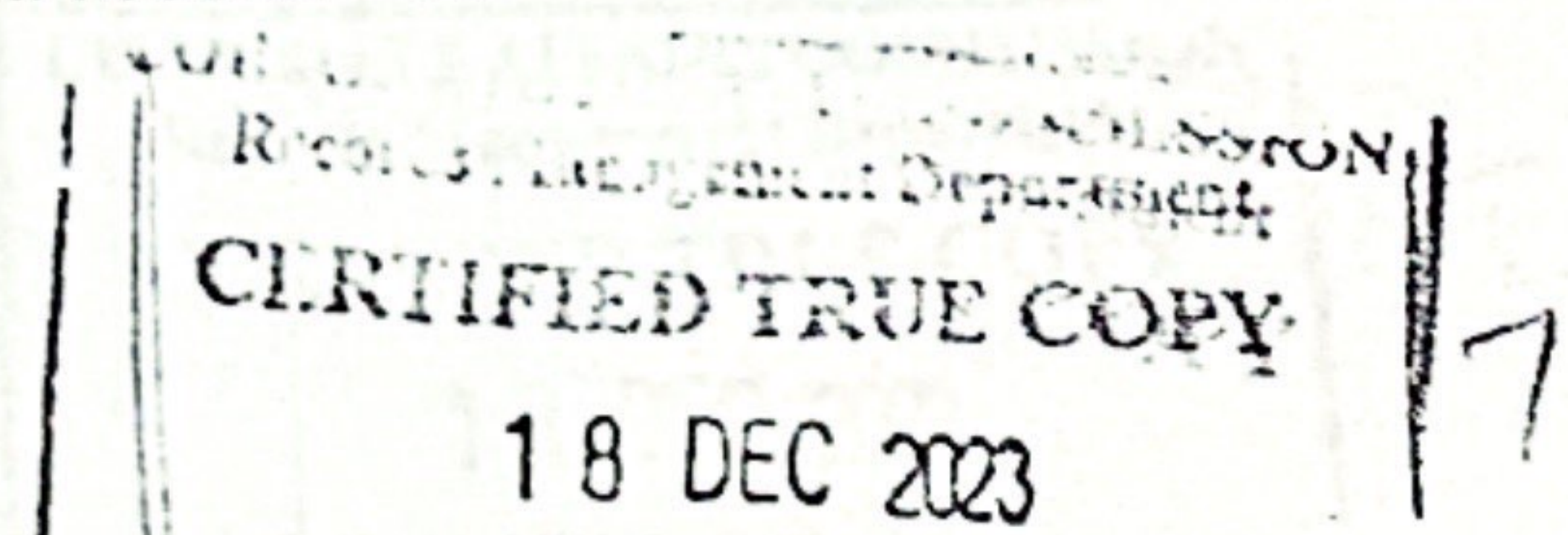
13 ELECTION AND ELECTORAL PROCESS:

- 13.1.1 There shall be for the Association an Electoral Committee (Elcom) charged with the responsibility of conducting Elections into Executive positions of ALGON.
- 13.1.2 A person shall be qualified to be a member of the Electoral Committee if:
- (a) He is a permanent member of the Association
 - (b) He is not an Executive member of the Association or in the case of person having Executive position, has to resign two months to the date of Election.

14 ELIGIBILITY TO CONTEST ELECTIONS:

A person shall be eligible to contest Election into Executive position of the Association if:

- (a) He is a permanent and financial member of the Association.
 - (b) For the purpose of this section a "Financial member" means a person whose financial obligation to the association are fully paid by his constituency (Local Government) and is free from any other financial encumbrance to the Association.
 - (c) He has been elected as State Chapter Chairman of the Association.
 - (d) The Officers of the Assistant Financial Secretary, Assistant Treasurers, Assistant Publicity Secretary, Assistant Auditors and Assistant Legal Adviser shall be contested for by the Vice Chairman of the 774 Local Government Councils.
 - (e) The elected Councillors shall contest for the offices of Ex-officio members
- 14.1.1 The Election into the Executive position of the Association shall be by open secret ballot.
- 14.2 A contestant shall be duly elected or deemed to have been duly elected into any of the Executive position if:
- a. He has a simple majority of the votes cast at the election.
 - b. He is unopposed to his nomination to the Executive position sought and/or nominated
 - c. Where a simple majority vote cannot be obtained at the Election, the Chairman of the Electoral Committee shall call for a second vote.



15 ELIGIBILITY TO VOTE AT ELECTIONS:

15.1 There shall be an Electoral College for the election into National Executive positions of ALGON (except for Vice President) consisting of a Chairman, Vice Chairman and one Councillor from each of the Local Government Councils or Area Council as the case may be.

15.2 REMOVAL OF ELECTED OFFICERS

15.3 Person holding any Executive position shall be removed from office if he is found to have misappropriated the funds of the Association or in breach of any of the provisions of the Constitution.

15.3.1 Subject to the provision of subsection (1) of this section a person holding any Executive position shall be removed where a motion for his removal is supported by a two third of the National Executive.

15.3.2 In the case of Vice-President his removal is supported in writing to the National Executive Council by 2/3 of members constituting his state chapter.

16. BOARD OF TRUSTEES ✓

16.1 The Board of Trustees of the Association for the purpose of the Companies and Allied Matters Decree No. 1 of 1990 shall be appointed at a general meeting:

16.1.1 Such Trustee's shall not be less than 6(six) and shall be known as 'THE REGISTERED TRUSTEES OF ASSOCIATION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENTS OF NIGERIA'.

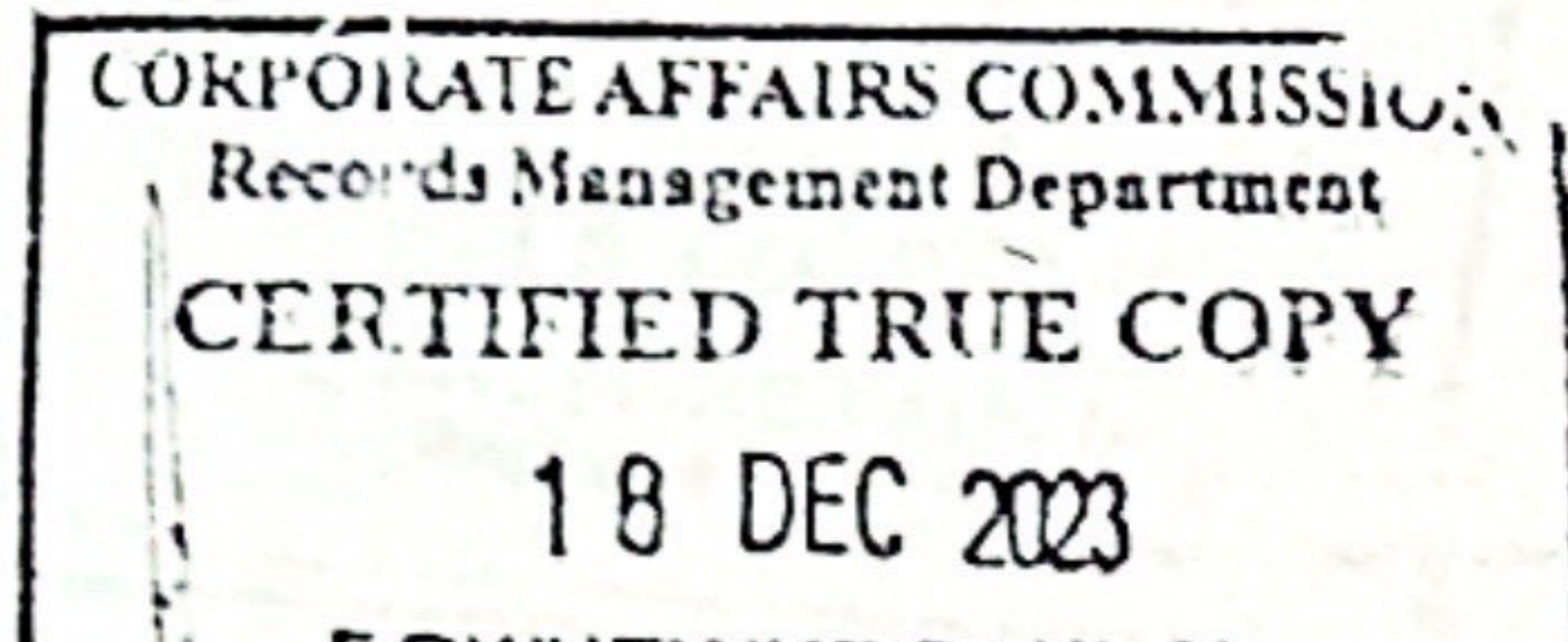
16.1.2 The Board of Trustees of the Association shall be made up as follows:

(a) incumbent National President and Secretary-General of the Association provided always that no President or Secretary shall remain a Trustee after serving an additional term;

(b) six members of the Association, one from each of the geo-political zones elected by the zones, provided such member shall not seek further elective office in the Association. The Zones shall be:

- (i) South-South
- (ii) North East
- (iii) North West
- (iv) South West
- (v) South East
- (vi) North Central;

(a) any such member of the Association as may from time to time be added by the Board itself subject to the guideline drawn by the Board bearing in mind the federal character principle of the country and subject to ratification by the general assembly of the Association.



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17 FUNCTIONS

- (i) The Trustees shall hold in trust all the assets, movable and immovable of the Association during all transition period.
- (ii) The Trustees shall be eligible to attend meetings of the National Executive Council on invitation to discuss matters related to the progress of the Association;
- (iii) The members of the Board of Trustees shall attend the annual Convention of the Association as Ex-officio members.

17.1 QUORUM

The quorum for the meeting of Trustees shall be (4) four members in attendance.

17.1A The Trustees, subject to provision of Section 19.1 (iii)(a) may hold office for life but a Trustee shall cease to hold office if he:

- (i) resigns his office;
- (ii) becomes insane;
- (iii) is officially declared bankrupt
- (iv) convicted of a criminal offence involving dishonesty by a Court of competent jurisdiction;
- (v) is recommended for removal from office by the National Executive Council ratified by the General Assembly;
- (vi) ceases to reside in Nigeria

17.1B upon a vacancy occurring in the number of Trustees, a general meeting will be held to appoint another eligible person to fill such vacancy.

17.2 CESSATION OF MEMBERSHIP

A member representing a Local Government Council, who ceases to be a member of that Local Government Council automatically ceases to be member of the Association, or any organ thereof.

17.3 HONORARY MEMBERSHIP

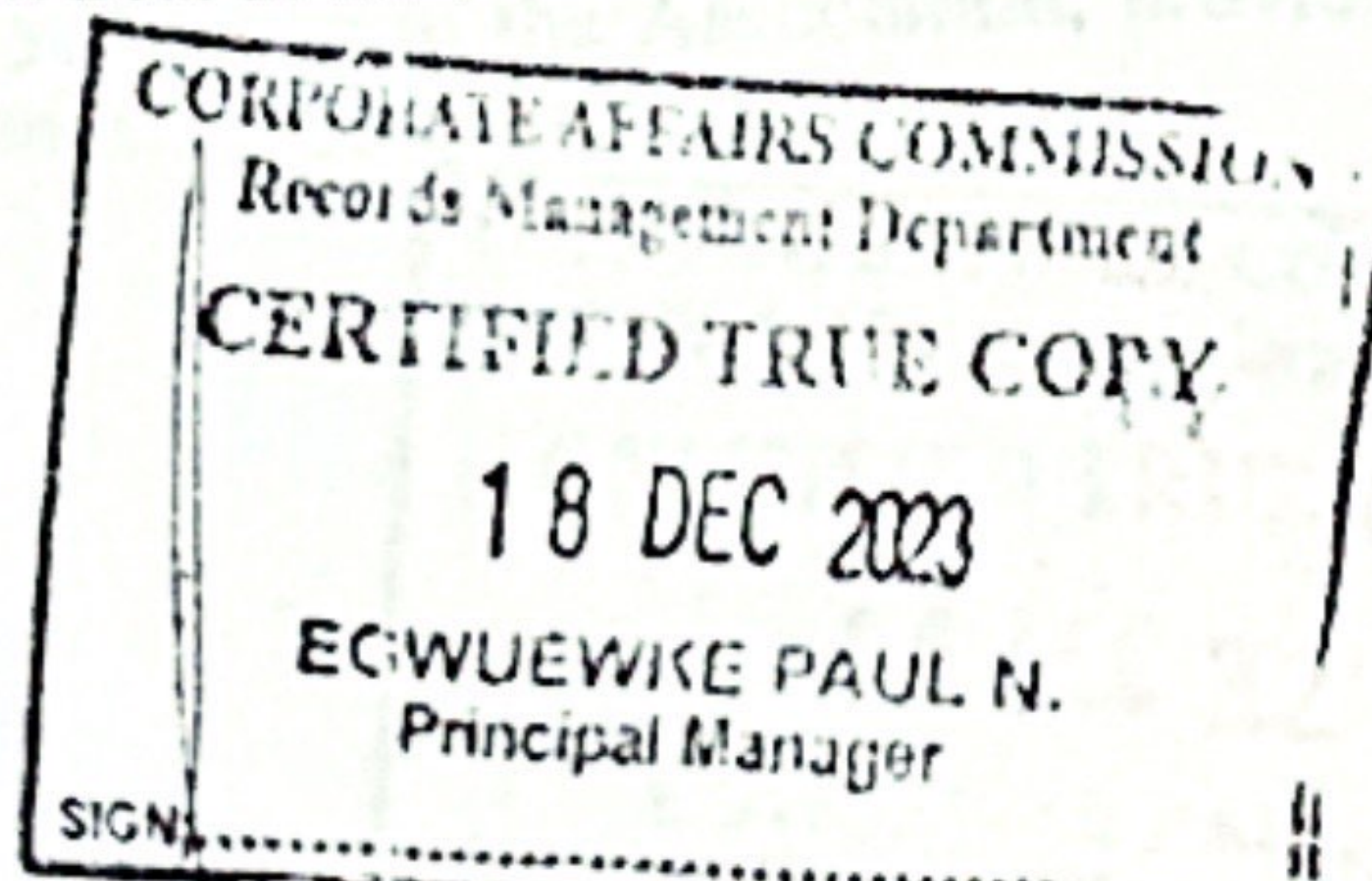
Any Special or Honorary member other than the Permanent member may voluntarily withdraw from the Association by giving notice of such withdrawal to the President.

17.4 THE GENERAL SECRETARY

17.4.1 The Secretary shall be the Chief Administrative Head of the Association and shall be responsible to the President and the National Executive Council;

17.4.2 The duties of the General Secretary may include:

- 17.4.2.1 Control of staff of the Association;
- 17.4.2.2 The appointment and discipline of staff below GL.06 in consultation with the President;
- 17.4.2.3 Preparation of the annual budget of the Association;
- 17.4.2.4 Being a co-signatory to all the accounts of the Association;
- 17.4.2.5 Keeping the minutes of the meetings and custody of all records including the Common Seal of the Association;



17.4.2 6 Serving as Secretary to the Assembly, the National Executive Council, Finance and Planning Committee and the Joint Consultative Committee;

17.4.2 7 Providing secretarial services to all other Committees.

17.5 COMMON SEAL ✓

- (1) The Association shall have a Common Seal.
- (2) Such Common Seal shall be kept in custody of the Secretary-General who shall produce it when required for use.
- (3) All documents to be executed by the Trustees shall be signed by at least five of the total number of Trustees and the document sealed with the Common Seal in the presence of such members signing.

18 FINANCE

The sources of income of the Association for the discharge of its functions may include:

- 18.1 Annual Subscriptions by members;
 - 18.1.1 Sales of Publications;
 - 18.1.2 Grants, Endowments, Donations and Gifts;
 - 18.1.3 Income from other sources.
- 18.2 Each Local Government Council as a member shall contribute as determined by the National Executive Council from time to time.
- 18.3 The State Chapter shall retain 30% of the total subscriptions arising from paragraph 18.1.
- 18.4 A financial member who persistently defaults for a period of 12 months in respect of fees, contributions, subscriptions and other financial obligations levied by the Association shall remain suspended until such obligations must have been discharged.

19. THE STATE CHAPTERS

- 19.1 All the Local Governments in each state shall constitute the State Chapter of the Association.
- 19.2 The provisions of this Constitution shall equally apply to the State Chapters of ALGON with such modifications and adaptations as Local circumstances may permit provided the general intent and substance are strictly complied with.

19.3 GENERAL PROVISIONS

- 19.3.1 Nothing in this Constitution prevents an individual member from becoming a member of other National and International Bodies concerned with Local Government.
- 19.3.2 Federal Character shall be observed in the appointments, elections and activities of the Association.
- 19.3.3 The Association shall have no regard for political, philosophical, religious, geographical or ethnic consideration.

20 AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION

- 20.1 The Constitution of the Association may when deemed necessary be amended at a General Assembly meeting of the Association, provided that a motion for such amendment shall be given to the General

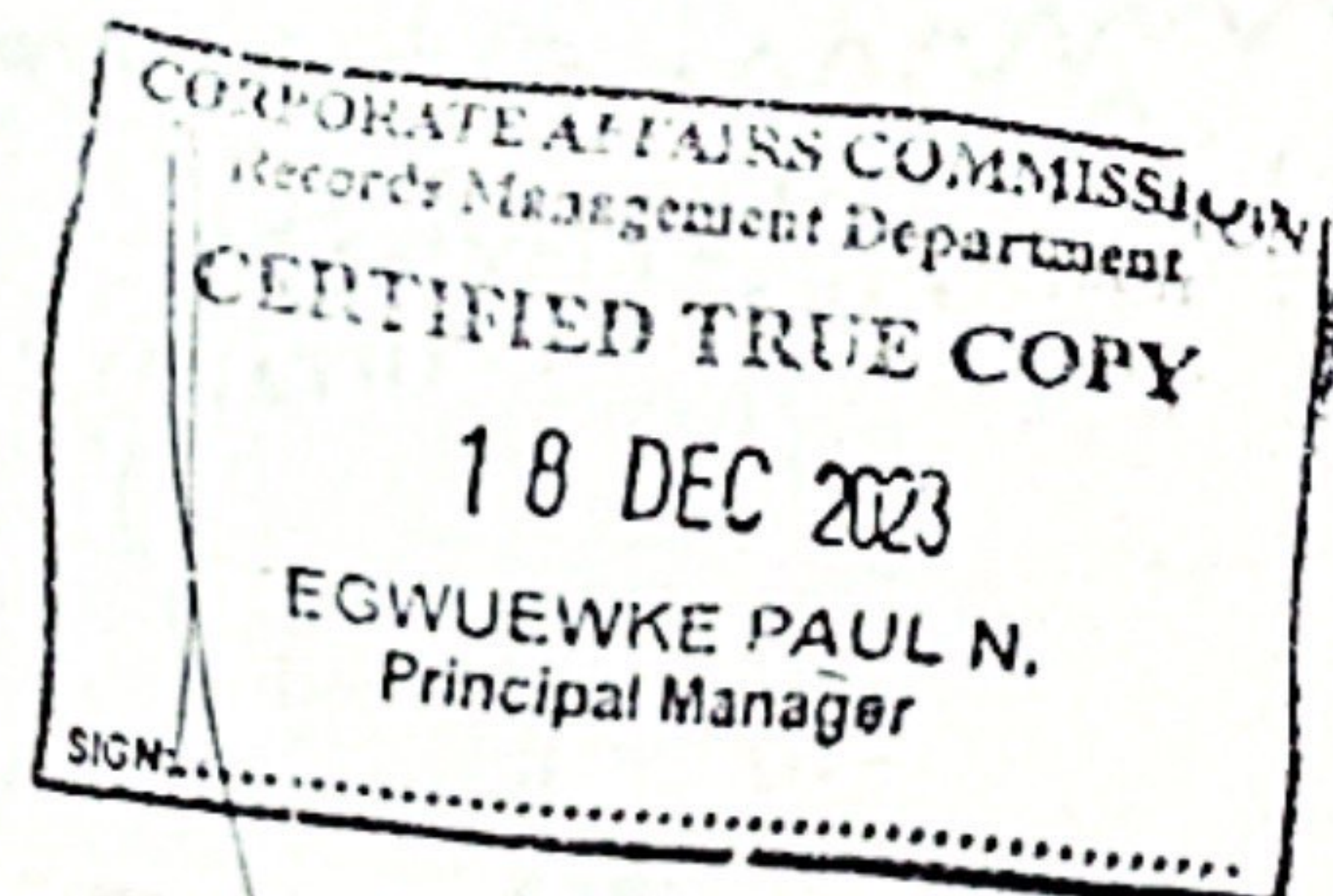
Assembly, three months before the date of the meeting and a copy sent to every member of the Association at least one month before such a meeting. Such amendment shall be carried by a resolution passed by a simple majority of members present and voting.

20.2 INTERPRETATION

"Association"	Means ALGON, that is, "The Association of Local Governments of Nigeria"
"Chapter"	Refers to the Branch or Unit of the Association at the State level.
"Committee"	Means a Committee established by the General Assembly or the National Executive Council or State Chapter including any standing committee or Ad-Hoc Committee.
"Council"	Wherever the word "Council" occurs, it means the National Executive Council of the Association.
"Constitution"	Means the Constitution of the Association of Local governments of Nigeria.
"Ex-officio"	Is a member either of the Assembly or the Council or the Committee who is thereby virtue of his office.
"Federal Government"	Means the Government of the Federal Republic of Nigeria.
"Financial Member"	Means a member who has met the stipulated financial obligations to the Association.
"Income from the Sources"	Means income receivable from sources approved by the National Executive Council or The General Assembly.
"National Executive Council"	Is the second highest authority of the Association established under the Constitution of the Association.
"Quorum"	Is a number that is less than one third of the total membership constituting any meeting.
"Standing Committee"	Means the regulations governing meetings of the Association at the National, State or Committee levels.

21 CITATION AND COMMENCEMENT

This Constitution shall be cited as The Constitution of the Association of Local Governments of Nigeria (ALGON) 1999 shall come into effect on 28th day of November, 1999.



SPECIAL CLAUSE ✓

At the General meeting of the above named Association held on the 29th day of November 1999 at which ASSOCIATION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF NIGERIA members were in attendance, it was resolved as follows;

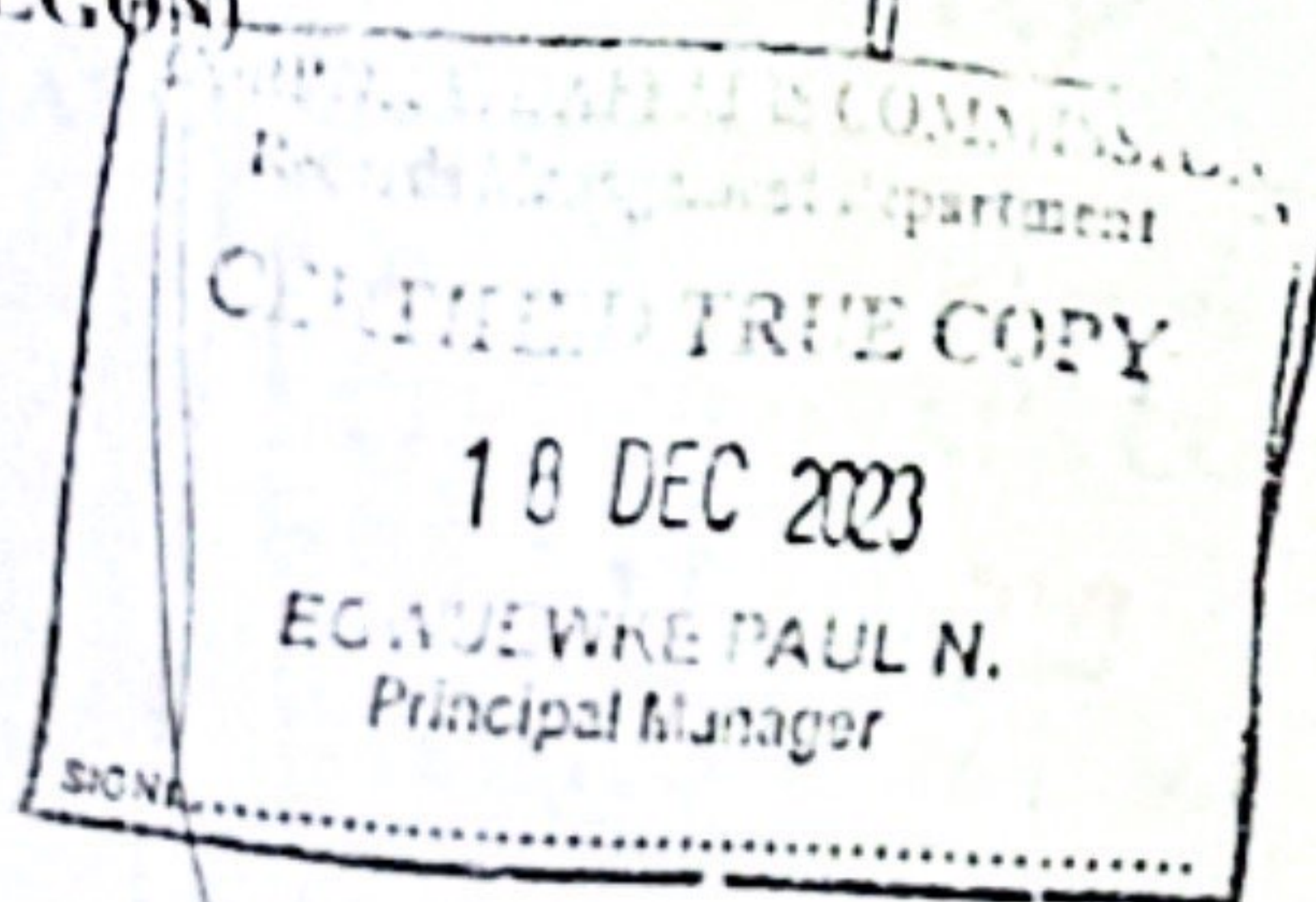
1. THE INCOME AND PROPERTY of the ASSOCIATION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF NIGERIA wheresoever derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects of the ASSOCIATION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF NIGERIA as set forth in this RULES AND REGULATIONS/CONSTITUTION and no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly, by way of dividend, to the member of the ASSOCIATION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF NIGERIA
2. PROVIDED that nothing herein shall prevent the payment, in good faith, of reasonable and proper remuneration to any officer or servant of the ASSOCIATION in return for any service actually rendered to the Association but so that no member of the Council of Management or Governing Body shall be appointed to any salaried office of the ASSOCIATION or any office of the ASSOCIATION paid by the fees, and that no remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the ASSOCIATION to any member except out-o-pocket expenses or reasonable and proper rent for premises demised, or let to the ASSOCIATION provided that the provision last aforesaid shall not apply to any payment of any company to any member of the ASSOCIATION may be a company in which such member shall not hold more than one hundredth part of the capital, and such member shall not be bound to account for any share of profits he may receive in respect of any such payment.
3. NO ADDITION, alteration, or amendment shall be made to or in the RULES AND REGULATIONS/CONSTITUTION for the time being in force unless the same has been previously submitted to and approved by the Registrar-General.
4. IN the event of a winding up or dissolution of the ASSOCIATION there remains, after the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, and property whatsoever, the same shall not be aid to or distributed among the members of the ASSOCIATION but shall be given or transferred to some other institution or institutions having objects similar to the objects of the ASSOCIATION and the body or bodies are prohibited from distributing its or their income and property amongst its or their members to an extent at least as great as is imposed on the ASSOCIATION under or by virtue of the SPECIAL CLAUSE hereof, such institution or institutions to be determined by the members of ASSOCIATION OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT OF NIGERIA, effect cannot be given to the aforesaid provision then to some charitable object.
